Specialty Periods, Free Choice, Tent Time, All Camp Activities

Specialty Periods offer campers the opportunity to increase their level of skill in a variety of areas. At the beginning of the week the kids are given explanations of all possible options, and choose two different specialties for the week. Each day they will spend an hour in the morning with the same instructor and campers learning a new skill. Options may include swimming lessons, boating*, dance, fishing, music, crafts, target sports, high ropes course*, zip-line*, slack-line, theater.

Free Choice activities occur each afternoon allowing campers to choose on a daily basis from all of our staff supervised activities. Traditional activities include arts and crafts, swimming, water trampoline, basketball, boating*, soccer, Gaga dodgeball, archery...and more.
